## KENTUCKY – CLIMATE

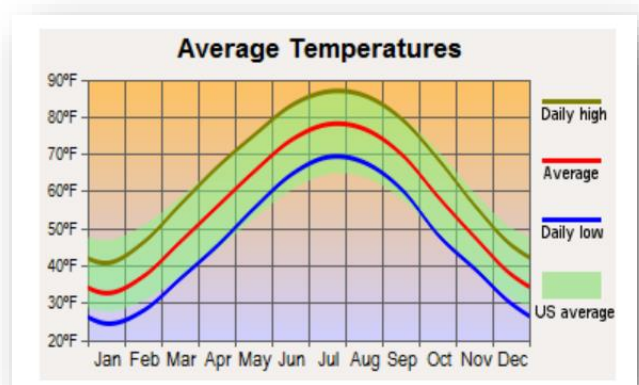

Kentucky enjoys a temperate climate and generally plentiful rainfall. The state's mean annual temperature is between 55 and 60 °F (13 and 16 °C). However, extremes of temperature exceeding 110 °F (43 °C) and dropping below -30 °F (-34 °C) have been recorded occasionally. In the capital city, average high temperatures in January and February are in the low 40s F (about 6 °C), and average low temperatures are in the low 20s F (about -5 °C); in July and August temperatures usually rise from the low 60s F (about 17 °C) into the mid-80s F (about 30 °C) daily. The yearly growing season lasts about 170 to 210 days, depending on location.

Mean annual precipitation is about 45 inches (1,140 mm). Although the fall months (September through November) are often somewhat drier, precipitation is generally well distributed throughout the year. The greatest differences occur between the southern areas, which receive nearly 50 inches (1,300 mm) annually, and the northeast, which may receive only 40 inches (1,000 mm). Thunderstorms are frequent and often cause flooding in eastern Kentucky. Prevailing winds are from the south and southwest, although north and northwest winds often bring the chill of winter.

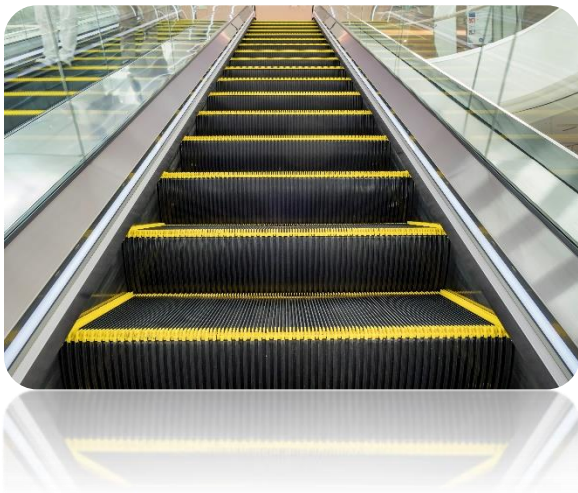

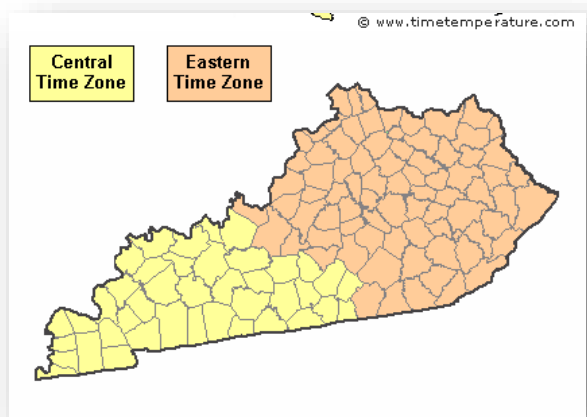

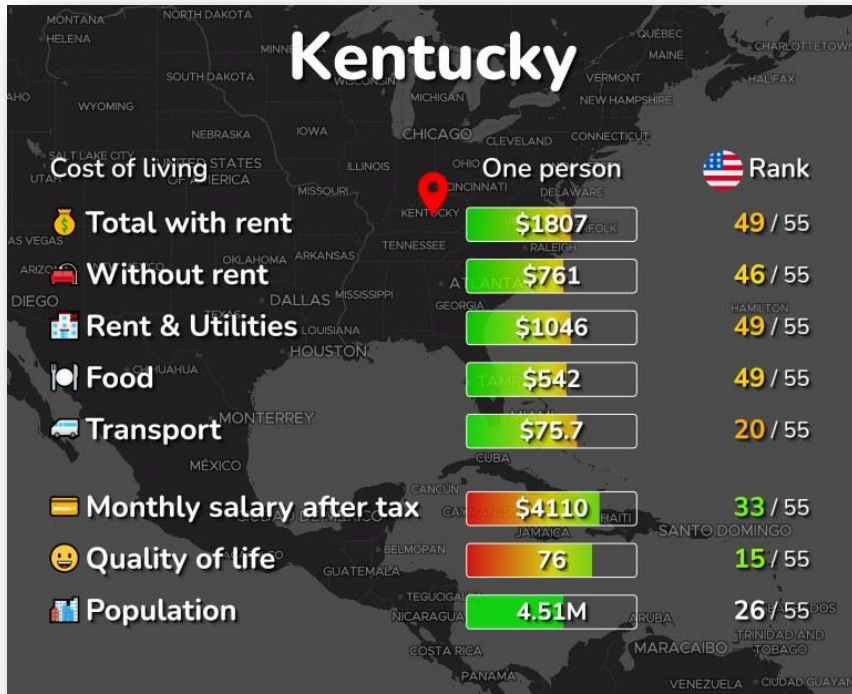

Eastern Time Zone Abbreviations	Eastern Standard Time - is abbreviated as EST Eastern Daylight Time - is abbreviated as EDT
Central Time Zone Abbreviations	Central Standard Time - is abbreviated as CST Central Daylight Time - is abbreviated as CDT
Eastern Time Zone UTC - GMT Offset	Eastern Time Zone is GMT/UTC - 5h during Standard Time Eastern Time Zone is GMT/UTC - 4h during Daylight Saving Time
Central Time Zone UTC - GMT Offset	Central Time Zone is GMT/UTC - 6h during Standard Time Central Time Zone is GMT/UTC - 5h during Daylight Saving Time
Daylight Saving Time Usage	Kentucky does utilize Daylight Saving Time.
Daylight Saving Start Date	Kentucky starts Daylight Saving Time on Sunday March 10, 2024 at 2:00 AM local time.
Daylight Saving End Date	Kentucky ends Daylight Saving Time on Sunday November 3, 2024 at 2:00 AM local time.
