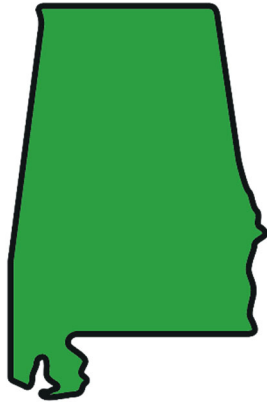

## ALABAMA – CLIMATE

The state is classified as humid subtropical (Cfa) under the Köppen climate classification.[1] The average annual temperature is 64 °F (18 °C). Temperatures tend to be warmer in the southern part of the state with its proximity to the Gulf of Mexico, while the northern parts of the state, especially in the Appalachian Mountains in the northeast, tend to be slightly cooler.[2] Generally, Alabama has very hot summers and mild winters with copious precipitation throughout the year. Alabama receives an average of 56 inches (1,400 mm) of rainfall annually and enjoys a lengthy growing season of up to 300 days in the southern part of the state.[2] Hailstorms occur occasionally in the spring and summer, but are seldom destructive. Thunderstorms occur throughout the year - they are most common in the summer, but most severe in the spring and fall, when destructive winds and tornadoes occasionally occur. Hurricanes are quite common in the state, especially in the southern part, and major hurricanes occasionally strike the coast which can be very destructive. Summers in Alabama are among the hottest in the United States, with high temperatures averaging over 90 °F (32 °C) throughout the summer in some parts of the state. The average annual temperature is highest in the southwest along the coast, and lowest in the northeast among the highlands. Thus, at Mobile the annual mean is 67 °F (19 °C), the mean for the summer 81 °F (27 °C); and at Valley Head, in De Kalb county, the mean for the summer 75 °F (24 °C). At Montgomery, in the central region, the average annual temperature is 66 °F (19 °C), with a summer average of 81 °F (27 °C). The highest temperature ever recorded was 109 °F (43 °C) in Talladega county in 1902.

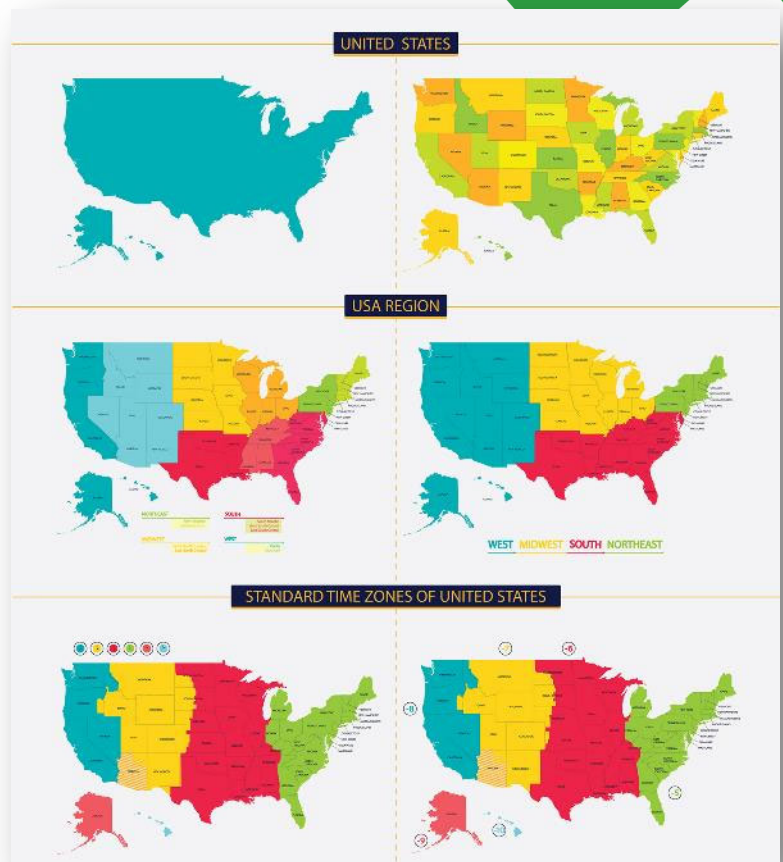
